# Chapter 5

## **Foreign Relations**

K109 has always sought to establish as many friendly international relationships as possible.

"Having formal allies benefits K109, but more importantly, it benefits Longfellow," said Mr. Huang. "I have always dreamed of seeing a tapestry of nations on the Field, each with its own proud leader, flag, and distinctive mission."

The first friendly international relationship was with the land belonging to Mr. Williams, but Mr. Williams never formalized his position over his people or his government. Therefore, 109 could not sign a treaty with his land.

### Tieland

The first treaty 109 ever signed was with faraway Tieland, led by Mr. Cheney. Tieland was a democratic government, but the two leaders still got along well. In the fall of 2007, Lancer Life, led by Mrs. Duggan, filmed Mr. Huang and Mr. Cheney in Tieland signing their ground-breaking treaty. Mr. Huang gave his famous speech "It's Good to Have Friends", where he urged all Longfellow fledgling nations to build strong friendships with each other.

#### Hughey School of Wordcraft and Imagery

In the fall of 2011, the second treaty was signed with the Hughey School of Imagery and Wordcraft (HSWI). HSWI was an English room with a mystical nature that intrigued Mr. Huang. Prior to signing the treaty, Mr. Huang visited HSWI and marveled at how peaceful this beautiful country was. According to its leader, Headmistress Hughey, the secret to HSWI's quiet and peaceful nature was kittens. After the treaty signing, 109 built its first ever embassy there and allowed HSWI to build an embassy in 109, which included a moat surrounding the building.

## **Starship Inquiry**

In the fall of 2012, a third treaty of alliance was signed with the journalism room Starship Inquiry, led by Captain Mrs. Duggan who by then was already well known in 109 for being the chief cinematographer for the Liberation of Tieland and Dr. Donut scenes in the documentary *Mangos and Large Potatoes*. By 2012, Mrs. Duggan had hung up her video camera and instead focused on Longfellow's PTB-approved newspaper, the <u>Longfellow Lead</u>. There were rumors that this alliance was a strategic move by Mr. Huang to be close to Longfellow's publication and have possible influence over what the PTB printed.

Starship Inquiry also housed the most famous K109 embassy in history. Built in early 2013 by the Daniel brothers, Teddy and Noah, the embassy could fly, had apartments and fire defenses, and was manned by autotropic munchkins trained in martial arts.

## The Queendom of 163

In the winter of 2016, the fourth treaty was signed with the Queendom of 163, led by Mrs. Collins, the orchestra teacher, also known as The Lady with the Wand. The decision to ally with 163 followed debate over whether to ally with band or orchestra. In the end, Mr. Huang sided with orchestra since he had been a member during his days as a young prince.

#### The Matharchy of 200

In June 2017, the fifth treaty was signed with the Matharchy of 200. Despite a relatively uneventful relationship, Mr. Huang has stated privately that, outside of 109's relationship with Mr. Williams, the relationship with the Matharchy of 200 and its leader Goddess Mrs. Sheldon (nee Godwin) has been the most important one of the five alliances.

## **Chapter 6**

## The Liberation of Tieland

The Phoss always said that boredom is one of the many seeds of evil intent. During 2007-08, evil forces grew within Longfellow because English teacher Mr. Calamito and Officer Morris got bored. Joining forces to think of something destructive to do, their idea was to take over Tieland. This became known as the First Darkness.

## The Takeover

## Chapter 7

In liberating Tieland from Calamito and Morris in 2008, 109 came to the aid of another nation. In 2009, the Kingdom of 109 came to the aid of all of Longfellow to face the Second Darkness.

### The One Donut

After two years of relative peace in Longfellow, the skies darkened again. A evil force from outside Longfellow began to influence the minds of some the teachers, including Mr. Gorgia and Ms. Shemonsky. The evil force was searching for something called the One Donut. The evil force identified himself as Dr. Donut. Following his direction, Shemonsky and Gorgia began searching all of Longfellow for locations of unusual levels of energy. When he had enough data, Dr. Donut entered Longfellow himself, and lo and behold, it was Mr. Calamito! Calamito honed in on a power source in the southeast region of Kingdom of 109. After some digging, he found the One Donut, but then Mr. Huang found him. Mr. Huang was ready to capture Calamito, but then Calamito began to talk his way out of his predicament. Using the tempting power of the Donut, he explained to Mr. Huang how sharing the Donut's power could help Mr. Huang improve and strengthen 109 and Longfellow. In his time away after escaping the dance therapy program, Calamito had learned mind control techniques from the mercenary mystics of the Gatehouse, and his newfound skills worked on Mr. Huang. Together, they seized the One Donut, but Mr. Calamito immediately took it for himself and ran from 109.

Calamito tripped near the Front Door, and the Donut slipped from his hands. In the vicinity and attracted by the power of the Donut, Mr. Bradford, Officer Morris and Mr. Cheney all dove for it. ### The Search for Calamito (aka Dr. Donut)

## Mr. Gorgia's Double-Cross

With the One Donut now in hand, the commando unit tied up Mr. Calamito and led him back to Longfellow, where Mrs. Duggan and Mr. Gorgia were waiting (Mr. Huang still didn't know that Mr. Gorgia was working with Calamito). This was the first time in a year that Mr. Huang set foot on Longfellow property since his self-imposed exile began. As Mr. Huang gave a short speech on a hill overlooking Longfellow, the masses rejoiced seeing Calamito in tow.
